BEER CHIEF JUDGE'S REPORT - STEPHEN NELSEN



2020 sees the tenth installment of the Royal Adelaide Beer and Cider Awards, in its current format, and we were gearing up as a committee to celebrate that milestone before the pandemic hit. I give credit to the RABCA committee and RA&HS Staff, particularly Katie Johnson, for their resilience and flexibility to adapt to the postponement and ultimately, the situation we found ourselves judging this year's competition.

What an unforgettable experience the judging was! Having to move venue and make drastic changes and precautions quite late in the planning due to COVID restrictions. Then, in the midst of judging first day, the lockdown was announced, and we had no choice but to soldier on and do our best I'm confident, even proud to say that the panels delivered good value to the exhibitors, remaining impartial and providing professional feedback with remarkable stamina!

It's my objective as chief judge to elevate our standards of unbiased, quality judging and critique even further over the coming years. I'll achieve this through introducing diversity, increased feedback, statistical analysis, group coaching, and personal communications.

2020 saw a record number of cider entries, and a handsome tally of beers from breweries from the very oldest to the very shiniest. We are dependent on exhibitors from far and wide, and I had early doubts the disruptive year would see a serious drop in entries, which was unfounded. I particularly thank the younger exhibitors from our regions and peninsulas, you know who you are, for your contributions.

As a competition, we were delighted this year with the quality and number of tap beer entries. Reflecting the changing industry towards smaller producers, with taprooms but without sophisticated packaging facilities, we'll continue to support and assist entrants with bulk beer. Thanks to our dispense partner Andale, we had testament to the freshness of keg over package, with this year's two top beers in show pouring off kegs.

We thank Jeff Wright working in the new appointment of Chief Steward, with a new and unique focus of wrangling the entries and exhibits into most appropriate judging flights and orders, and mustering the stewards. This innovation will streamline the process and give us greater consistency in keeping similar products together. I've been able to ensure that all entries in each class are judged by the same panel.

Congratulations to all the medal winners and trophy takers, and let's look to a brighter and beer filled 2021!
